PROJECTION

Current rapid changes in the economic picture of both Connecticut and the city of Hartford mandate re-examination of the College's mission. The Legislative Task Force Report on Community-Technical Colleges will also have a major impact on the mission. Therefore, the College Accreditation Committee recommends the creation of a Mission Statement Committee to regularly re-evaluate the mission and purposes and make recommendations and/or changes. It further recommends a different process, which should include an environmental scan and broad participation from the College and community, in formulating CCTC's mission.

The Mission Statement Committee could also address the issues of technological education, student services, identification of the students, and conciseness. This committee should be a part of the College's governance structure and could meet once every two years.
