Businesses and community organizations will be able to access - through a single point of contact - a pipeline of highly-skilled interns and potential employees, establish partnerships with the Center, receive customized training for their current employees, use state-of-the-art facilities, and identify scholarship and grant opportunities. The Center will also serve the greater community by offering career fairs, free tax preparation, arts and cultural events, conferences, and workplace simulation classrooms.

The Center is the only one of its kind in Connecticut. It incorporates best-in-class programs that have been designed and implemented by Capital Community College in partnership with major insurance and financial services companies, along with healthcare, government, and community organizations. An early collaboration - the Financial Opportunity - F.I.R.S.T (Financial Independence to Reach Success and Transformation) - was created in partnership with Guardian, and the Career & Talent Development department is a result of the highly successful internship and registered apprenticeship programs developed with Travelers, The Hartford, Aetna, and United Healthcare.

The Center comprises the following departments: Workforce & Continuing Education, Career & Talent Development, Financial Opportunity – F.I.R.S.T, Grants & Sponsored Programs, and Business & Community Engagement.
