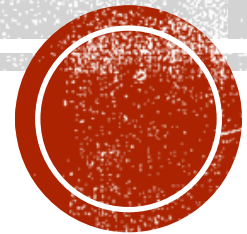

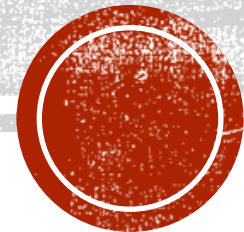

(A) You will be referred to the **R I S E** program- *RISE is designed to provide you with personaliz support and coaching that will assist you in improving your academic performance.*

(Q) I have a Academic Probation hold on my account what should I do?

(A) Your GPA fell below 2.0 within that semester, meet with the Advising and Counseling to have hold removed. If you GPA does not increase the following semester you will be placed on Academic Suspension.

(Q) How do I get on the Dean's List?

(A) Once your GPA is 3.4 and full-time student in the current semester you will be placed on the Dean's list.

(Q) How can I join Phi Theta Kappa (PTK) *the largest honor society, serving students at colleges around the world?*

(A) GPA requirements is 3.5
