#### What is BlackBoard?

Blackboard is a web-based course-management system designed to allow students and faculty to participate in classes delivered **ONLINE**.

#### How do I upload my assignments in BlackBoard?

Complete assignments in WORD and attach them in an email using the **MESSAGES tab** or otherwise instructed by your professor.

Students can contact their professor(s) through email or in the **MESSAGES tab** in BlackBoard.

- 4) Speak to a Guided Pathways Advisor.



## WITHDRAWAL PROCESS

Visit or contact the **Registrar's Office** on the second floor or email
<u>Ca-Registrar@capitalcc.edu</u> to request a withdrawal.

> A (W) grade will appear on the official transcript for courses from which a student withdraws.

> Failure to properly withdraw from a course may result in a failing grade.

> Withdrawing from a course(s) may affect your financial aid.

> You will be charged and will need to pay to retake the course the following semester.


