About our Art Classes (course catalog descriptions)

DRAWING I - ART 1110 On Display and Running in Spring, CRN: 45253

An introduction to the fundamental elements and language of drawing! Perceptual skills developed through observational drawing. Emphasis on the representation of threedimensional form on the two-dimensional picture plane, spatial relationships, perspective, and composition. Students create a portfolio of expressive drawings including still life, perspective studies and a self-portrait. Offered every semester.

FIGURE DRAWING I - ART 1330 Running in Spring, CRN: 47388

This course is based in both anatomical and expressive approaches to human figure drawing. A variety of media will be explored, including color and wet media, along with instruction in composition, proportion, and foreshortening principles. Students work extensively from the live model in nude and clothed form. Offered in Spring.

TWO-DIMENSIONAL DESIGN - ART 1210 On Display

An exploration of the concepts underlying visual organization in two-dimensional art and design. Students undertake a series of studio projects aimed at uncovering basic design elements (line, shape, value, texture, space), properties, and principles (balance, unity, emphasis, repetition, rhythm, etc.). Offered in Fall.

THREE-DIMENSIONAL DESIGN - ART 1220 Running in Spring, CRN: 47387

Three-Dimensional Design explores concepts of three-dimensional art and design. Students undertake a series of studio projects aimed at uncovering basic design elements, properties, and principles. Development of personal content using a variety of three-dimensional tools, materials, and processes. Emphasis placed on visual and creative thinking and problem solving. Offered in Spring.

DIGITAL PHOTO - ART 1450 On Display and Running in Spring, CRN: 42440

An introduction to digital photography including camera operation, file formats and management and image editing using Adobe Photoshop. Through demonstrations, assignments, critiques, a survey of imagery and a final portfolio, students are introduced to the basic vocabulary, concepts, tools and expressive possibilities of digital photography.

PAINTING I – ART 1510 On Display and Running in Spring, CRN: 45250

A course in the technical and aesthetic fundamentals of painting, covering construction of a canvas, selection and use of materials, basic color theory, and realistic and expressive paint handling. Students work in both traditional and experimental painting styles. Drawing I is recommended but not required. Offered every semester.

PAINTING II - ART 1520 Running in Spring, CRN: TBA

A course building on the skills learned in Painting I and expanding into concerns of abstract and non-objective forms of painting. Continued emphasis on materials, processes, and experimentation at an intermediate level towards a personal expression with the medium. Offered every Spring.






